

Sowing Fifteen-Inch Seeds with the Big Guns



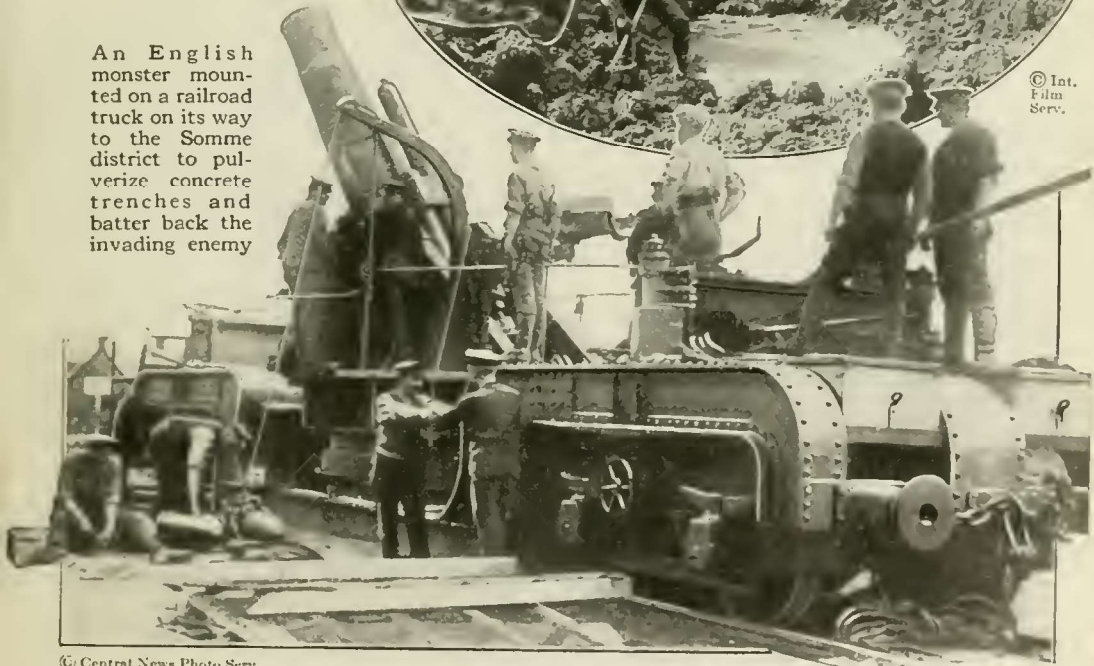
