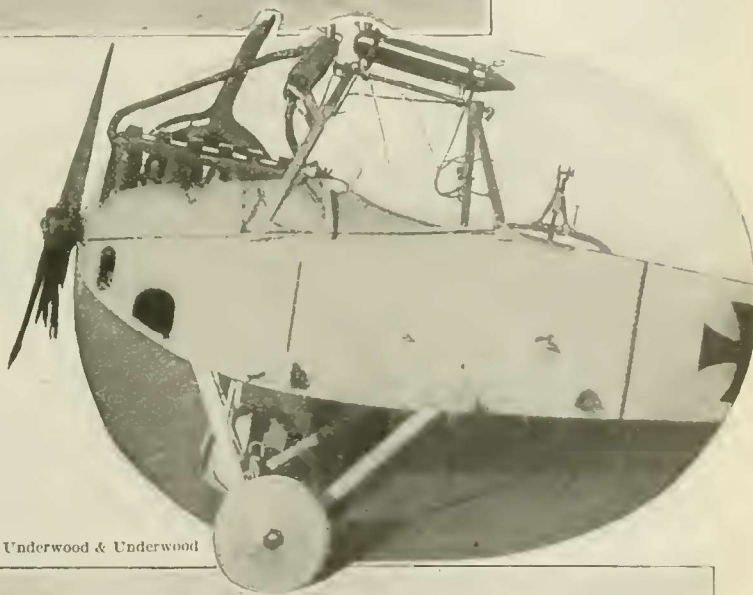


## Rapid-Fire Guns and Their Victim



A new British machine-gun equipped for cavalry work. The gun is extremely light, and may be easily carried on the back of one horse. In an emergency it may be assembled for action in a very few minutes
