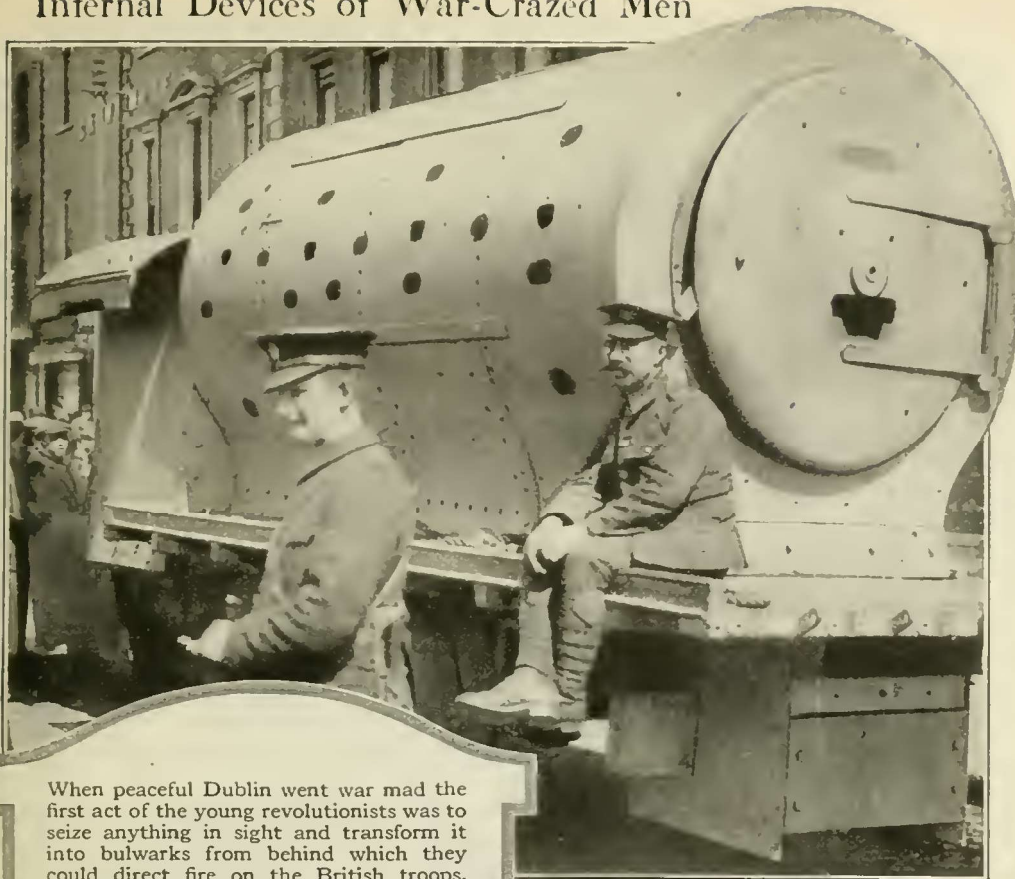


## Infernal Devices of War-Crazed Men
